Evaluation of Social Needs Among Orphan Students in AL- Qadisiyah City / Iraq

ABSTRACT

Objective: To evaluation of social needs among orphan students in AL- Qadisiyah city /Iraq.

Material: A quantitative research, descriptive correlational design study was carried out among Orphans Students of Secondary Schools in AL- Qadisiyah Governorate for the period from 13een March 2022 to 1st December 2022. The sample consist of (200) elementary orphans' students of secondary schools in AL- Qadisiyah Governorate, Iraq were participated in the study. A non-probability sampling (convenience sample).
